#### "Rules and Guidelines for Exhibitors" Contract

#### **Application Rules:**

All applications must follow these rules and guidelines for exhibitors and be approved by the Earth Day Mobile Bay 2011 organizing committee.

- 1. **Deadline**: Applications must be post marked by **April 1**, **2011**.
- 2. The 'Rules and Guidelines for Exhibitors' Contract (this age and the next) and the Application Form (page 4) must be filled out completely, signed, and returned.
- 3. The voluntary registration donation for government and non-profit organizations is \$10.00 or more. The voluntary registration donation for small businesses is \$50.00 or more. For corporations, we appreciate your best help! 100% of all financial support goes to the production of Earth Day Mobile Bay 2011. There are no paid employees. Earth Day Mobile Bay is a 501(c)(3) Non-Profit organization. All contributions are tax deductible.
- 4. The Voluntary Registration Donation, Application, and Contract should be submitted by mail. Additional questions can be submitted by telephone, mail or e-mail:

#### Rules and Guidelines for Exhibits:

- Exhibit space dimensions can be customized to your specific needs. Indicate your particular space and activity needs or special accommodations on your application, and we will do our best to see that your needs are met.
- 2. Exhibitors must provide their own signs, tables, chairs, tools, tents, tent tie-downs, water hoses, outdoor power extension cords, and other accessories. Indicate the size of your tent on the application.
- 3. Exhibitors might be grouped into one of the festival's educational areas according to their focus or purpose. The planning committee will do its best to place you in the most appropriate area.
- 4. Domesticated animals are not considered exhibits. Wildlife may be displayed only if it serves an educational, environmental purpose. Exhibits are only displays. No public handling of animals is allowed. The animals are the responsibility of the organization bringing them to the event. All necessities including their shelter, food, water, safety equipment, and sanitary equipment are required.
- 5. Applications submitted before the deadline will be assigned a space on a first-received, first-serve basis. Electrical and water outlets are limited and will be assigned the same way.
- 6. All exhibits MUST BE educational and environmentally focused. We encourage interactive or hands-on activities and exhibits.
- 7. Exhibitors CANNOT use their exhibit or the festival area to advocate for or against any elected official, candidate or political party.
- 8. All exhibits must follow the rules and guidelines listed. A section is provided on the application to describe the content and purpose of your exhibit. By signing this application, you agree to abide by the rules and guidelines. Any business or organization not following these guidelines will be asked to leave the event area.
- 9. **Set-up** begins at 7:00 AM and all exhibits must be set-up by 9:30 AM.
- 10. All exhibits should be **staffed** from 10:00 AM to 6:00 PM.
- 11. **Breakdown** of exhibits can begin at 6:00 PM (NO SOONER) and must be completed by 8:00 PM.
- 12. The Earth Day Mobile Bay festival is a **LITTER FREE** event. Please help us achieve this by considering the following at your exhibit:
  - You may hand out a one-page flyer that summarizes your business or organization with your Web site address or instructions on how to get more information.
     Please consider not distributing items that could end up as litter.
  - Please **Pick up any litter** you see and direct people to the nearest trash or recycling container.

#### Day of Occurrence for Earth Day Mobile Bay 2011:

1. 'Earth Day Mobile Bay 2011' will take place, **RAIN or SHINE\***, at the Fairhope Pier in the city of Fairhope, AL, on Saturday, April 23, 2011, from 10:00 AM to 7:00 PM. (Exhibits: 10:00 AM – 6:00 PM, Live Music: 10:00 AM – 7:00 PM) (\* in case of <u>severe</u> weather, EDMB will use community notification systems (e.g. radio and TV) to announce event cancellation. Email notification to exhibitors will also be used.)

#### Agreement:

organization in connection with this contract and our participation in the Earth Day Mobile Bay 2011 event.
