2026 Exhibitor Setup Procedures

The procedure numbers correspond to numbered circles on page 2 map.

1. **Arrival:** One arrives at Fairhope Municipal Pier Park to a central fountain, surrounded by a one-way traffic Fountain Circle road. Turn right to navigate around the Fountain Circle.

Handicapped and reserved parking spaces may NOT be used and the traffic lane must not be blocked.

2. An **unloading area** is to the south of the Fountain Circle. Temporarily park in the Unload Area (parking area marked by **blue lines**) and Unload your exhibit in the area marked by **green hatch marks** on the attached map - but set up only after you park in North Park.

3. **Check in at the Information Booth:** Be prepared to give your name and exhibit name. You will be given your space number, an exhibitor parking card to be placed in your windshield (for free parking), and further instructions about unloading.

We are not allowed to drive vehicles in the park nor on its sidewalks. Volunteer staff help may be requested at the Information Booth and staff will be stationed around the sidewalk to help you find your space.

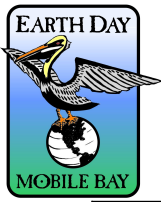
4. **Unload quickly:** There is a queue with others waiting. Do not set up until after moving and parking your vehicle in North Park. Unloaded exhibit baggage may be left in the green unload area prior to being taken to ones booth location.

5. **Park your vehicle:** Continue to the North Beach Park parking area. Show the attendant your parking card if applicable.

6. **Setup:** After parking, return to your space to setup your exhibit. Fairhope requests that tent stakes and ground spikes not be used. Please only use hanging weights or similar to anchor tents and tarps.

7. **Information Booth:** for questions about electrical or water supply requirements, et al.
